

Real Estate Activities on Selected ATC Transmission Line to Begin in Spring

In their recent update American Transmission Company announced that for the Morgan-Werner West Transmission Line Project that Steigerwaldt Land Services, Inc., Tomahawk will carry out the real estate activities on behalf of ATC.

Property owners along the approved route will be contacted by a real estate representative from Steigerwaldt. This representative will be identified by the company badge and will provide landowners with information concerning the project and the easement acquisition process.

For landowners between Clintonville and New London the proposed real estate contact schedule is in the spring of 2007. In addition the proposed schedule for those living on the segment between the Badger Substation and the Clintonville Substation and includes the village of

Embarrass will also be in the spring of 2007.

The route runs from the Morgan substation in the Town of Morgan, Oconto County, west to and through the newly-approved Central Wisconsin substation located next to the existing Badger substation in the town of Belle Plaine, continuing south to the Werner west substation located in the City of New London and the town of Maple Creek, Outagamie County.

In general, the route approved by the Public Service Commission follows the preferred route proposed by ATC.

The route selected for this 345 kV line is about 50 miles long and uses a combination of corridors including an existing transmission line, highways, and roads, and an abandoned railroad corridor.
